GENDER PAY ANALYSIS AND REPORT

Gender pay analysis calculates the difference between the average earnings of men and women in a workforce. The analysis determines which employees are eligible for inclusion, and uses data on their ordinary pay, bonuses, and hours worked.

The gender pay gap is a key statistic and reports the difference in average women's earnings as a percentage of men's earnings. It was estimated the gender pay gap in the Channel Islands is 21% (i.e. on average women earn 21% less than men).*

We report on mean gender pay gap, median gender pay gap, mean bonus gender pay gap, proportion of males and females receiving a bonus payment, and proportion of males and females in each quartile band. Optional enhanced analysis is available to improve understanding of the causes of any gender pay gap.

WHY HAVE A GENDER PAY ANALYSIS?

Measuring the gender pay gap demonstrates an organisation's commitment to having a diverse and inclusive workforce.

Diverse and inclusive businesses often attract the best talent and these values can be important for customers and investors.

Gender pay analysis can help organisations to identify issues and opportunities. An organisation's calculations can also be used to establish a baseline and monitor progress.

Many employers annually report on and publish their gender pay gap. In the UK reporting is mandatory for employers with a headcount of 250 or more employees.
